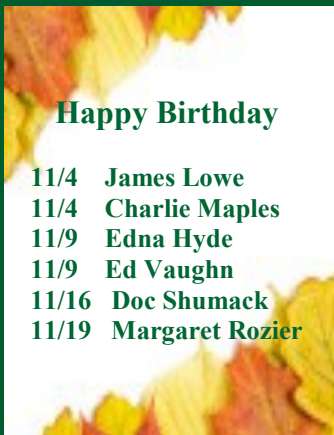
Message from Beryl
