but I want to make ours feel special. The party will be **March 2nd at 1:30**. Don't miss the fun and bring a friend.

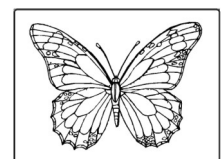


### Between the Lines Club Meets Again
